6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 551, Health and Safety
7 Code, is amended by adding Section 551.008 to read as follows:

8 <u>Sec. 551.008. REGIONAL LAUNDRY CENTERS. A regional laundry</u> 9 <u>center operated by the commission to provide laundry services to</u> 10 <u>department facilities may contract with federal agencies, other</u> 11 <u>state agencies, or local political subdivisions to provide or</u> 12 <u>receive laundry services.</u>

13 SECTION 2. Section 551.009(c), Health and Safety Code, is 14 amended to read as follows:

15 (c) The local mental health authority shall contract with 16 Kerrville State Hospital to provide food service, laundry service, 17 and lawn care to the local mental health authority operating a 18 crisis stabilization unit on the grounds of the Kerrville State 19 Hospital as provided by this section.

SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the

1 waiver or authorization is granted.

2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
