| 12 | other members of the governmental body without [conspires to         |
| 13 | circumvent this chapter by meeting in numbers less than] a quorum    |
| 14 | present regarding a tacit or explicit agreement to act uniformly in  |
| 15 | sufficient number to constitute a quorum concerning:                 |

- 1  $\underline{\text{(c)}}$  [\(\frac{(b)}{}\)] An offense under Subsection (a) is a misdemeanor
- 2 punishable by:
- 3 (1) a fine of not less than \$100 or more than \$500;
- 4 (2) confinement in the county jail for not less than
- 5 one month or more than  $six\ months;$  or
- 6 (3) both the fine and confinement.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
