9	ASSESSMENT INSTRUMENT PREPARATION. (a) The agency shall develop
10	interactive electronic tutorials that provide a comprehensive
11	review for each end-of-course assessment instrument listed in
12	Section 39.023(c).
13	(b) From funds appropriated for purposes of this section,
14	the agency shall make the tutorials developed under Subsection (a)
15	available to public school students and classroom teachers through
16	an online repository for classroom-ready instructional resources
17	operated by the agency.
18	(b-1) The agency shall provide the tutorials developed
19	under Subsection (a) through an online repository for
20	classroom-ready instructional resources not later than the
21	2020-2021 school year. This subsection expires September 1, 2021.
22	(c) A public school student or classroom teacher may not be
23	charged a fee for access to a tutorial provided through an online

- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
