BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Section 1, Article 49.25, Code of Criminal

6 Procedure, is amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 1. OFFICE AUTHORIZED. Subject to the provisions of this <u>article</u> [Act], the <u>commissioners court</u> [Commissioners Court] 8 of any county having a population of more than  $\underline{two}$  [one] million 9 [and not having a reputable medical school as defined in Articles 10 4501 and 4503, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, shall establish 11 12 and maintain the office of medical examiner, and the commissioners <u>court</u> [Commissioners Court] of any county may establish and provide 13 for the maintenance of the office of medical examiner. Population 14 shall be according to the last preceding federal census. 15

16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
