- 24 (c-1) In addition to the requirements of Subsection (c), the

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1 entry for each emergency services district and municipal utility district in the database must include: 2 (1) an indication of how a person may contact a 3 specified person or address to obtain: 4 5 (A) contact information for board members; and 6 (B) <u>meeting agendas and minutes;</u> 7 (2) the term of each board member; and 8 (3) information provided to the comptroller under Section 775.046(c), Health and Safety Code, or Section 54.244(c), 9 10 Water Code, as applicable. SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 775, Health and Safety 11 12 Code, is amended by adding Section 775.046 to read as follows: Sec. 775.046. ONLINE PUBLICATION. 2	(d) A district shall maintain:
3	(1) an Internet website; or
4	(2) an Internet domain name that:
5	(A) includes a form of the name of the district;
6	and
7	(B) directs a user to the district's entry in the
8	<pre>comptroller database.</pre>
9	(e) If the district maintains an Internet website, the board
10	shall ensure that the following items are posted on the Internet
11	website and that the items required by Subdivisions (3), (4), and
12	(5) are updated on the district's Internet website at least 90 days
13	before the date of an election held by the district:
14	(1) a link to the district's entry in the comptroller
15	database;
16	(2) the name and term of each director;
17	(3) the information described by Subsections
18	(c)(1)-(3);

22	(f) A district shall provide a link to the Internet website
