- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter M, Chapter 441, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 441.231 to read as follows:
- Sec. 441.231. ONLINE LIBRARY RESOURCES FOR SCHOOL 8
- 9 DISTRICTS. (a) The commission shall use funds appropriated to the
- commission or consortium services fees under Section 441.224(b) 10
- collected from school districts to purchase online library 11
- 12 resources for primary and secondary schools that have adopted
- Internet safety policies and technology protection measures 13
- 14 meeting the requirements for certification under 47 U.S.C. Sections
- 254(h)(5)(B) and (C). 15
- (b) The commission may purchase online library resources 16
- under Subsection (a) only if the vendor providing the resources 17
- certifies that the resources comply with 47 U.S.C. Section 18
- 254(h)(5). 19
- (c) If the legislature finds that a vendor subject to 20
- 21 Subsection (b) is failing to comply substantially with the
- requirements of 47 U.S.C. Section 254(h)(5), the commission may 22
- 23 withhold further payments to the vendor pending verification of
- 24 compliance with that federal law.

- 1 (d) If the vendor described by Subsection (c) fails to
- 2 timely verify that the vendor is in compliance with federal law, the
- 3 commission may consider the vendor's act of noncompliance as a
- 4 breach of contract.
- 5 (e) Not later than December 1 of each fiscal year, the
- 6 commission shall submit to the Legislative Budget Board and the
- 7 office of the governor a report on any issues related to vendor
- 8 compliance with technology protection measures required by 47
- 9 U.S.C. Section 254(h)(5).
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
