- 11 (2) that a staff member of the facility will inform the
- 12 person of the person's rights before questioning, assessing, or
- 13 examining the person [within 24 hours after the time the person is
- 14 admitted to a facility], as provided by Section 573.025(b).
- SECTION 2. Section 573.025(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 (b) A person apprehended, detained, or transported for
- 18 emergency detention under this subtitle shall be informed of the
- 19 rights provided by this section and this subtitle:
- 20 (1) orally in simple, nontechnical terms, <u>before the</u>
- 21 person is questioned, assessed, or examined [within 24 hours after
- 22 the time the person is admitted to a facility], and in writing in
- 23 the person's primary language if possible; or
- 24 (2) through the use of a means reasonably calculated

- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
