## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the authority of a county fire marshal to provide fire-related training programs for first responders. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 352.019, Local Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 352.019. COOPERATION WITH OTHER FIRE PROTECTION AGENCIES; TRAINING FOR FIRST RESPONDERS. 8 SECTION 2. Section 352.019(e), Local Government Code, is 9 amended to read as follows: 10 (e) A county commissioners court may authorize the fire 11 12 marshal to provide training programs relating to fire-fighting and fire prevention and operate a training facility for first 13 14 responders [the various fire-fighting and fire prevention units] in the county. The county may establish and collect a reasonable fee 15 for the training programs, use of the facility, and services 16 provided by the facility. In this subsection, "first responder" has 17 the meaning assigned by Section 421.095, Government Code. 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22

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Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
