A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to size limitations for certain vehicles transporting agricultural products and equipment. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 622.101, Transportation Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as 6 follows: 7 Except as provided by Subsection (c), a [A] single motor 8 (a) 9 vehicle or truck-tractor operated in combination with a semitrailer and trailer or semitrailer and semitrailer used exclusively to 10 11 transport chile pepper modules, seed cotton, cotton, cotton burrs, 12 hay, or equipment used to transport or process chile pepper modules, [or] cotton, or hay, including a motor vehicle or burr 13 spreader, may not be operated on a highway or road if the vehicle 14 is: 15 (1) wider than 10 feet and the highway has not been 16 designated by the commission under Section 621.202; 17 18 (2) longer than 48 feet, if the vehicle is a single motor vehicle; or 19 (3) higher than 14 feet 6 inches, if the vehicle is a 20 21 single motor vehicle. 22 (c) Subsection (a) does not apply to a vehicle transporting 23 cylindrical bales of hay under a permit issued under Section 24 623.017 or 623.071(a)(1).

SECTION 2. Section 622.902, Transportation Code, is amended
to read as follows:

3 Sec. 622.902. LENGTH EXCEPTIONS. The length limitations 4 provided by Sections 621.203 to 621.205 do not apply to:

5 (1) machinery used exclusively for drilling water 6 wells, including machinery that is itself a unit or that is a unit 7 mounted on a conventional vehicle or chassis;

8 (2) a vehicle owned or operated by a public, private,9 or volunteer fire department;

10 (3) a vehicle or combination of vehicles operated 11 exclusively in the territory of a municipality or to a combination 12 of vehicles operated by a municipality in a suburb adjoining the 13 municipality in which the municipality has been using the equipment 14 or similar equipment in connection with an established service to 15 the suburb;

(5) a drive-away saddlemount vehicle transporter combination or a drive-away saddlemount with fullmount vehicle transporter combination, as defined by 23 C.F.R. Part 658 or its successor, if:

No. 3762 1 excluding the length of the truck-tractor, is not longer than 81-1/2 feet; and 2 3 (C) the combination is traveling on a highway that: 4 5 (i) is not part of the national system of interstate and defense highways or the federal aid primary highway 6 7 system; and 8 (ii) is located in a county with а population of less than 300,000; or 9 (9) a truck-tractor operated in combination with a 10 semitrailer and trailer or semitrailer and semitrailer if: 11 12 (A) the combination is used to transport chile pepper modules, seed cotton, cotton, cotton burrs, hay, or 13 equipment used to transport or process chile pepper modules, 14 15 cotton, or hay, including a motor vehicle or burr spreader; and 16 (B) the overall length of the combination is not 17 longer than: 18 (i) 75 feet if the combination is traveling on a highway that is part of the national system of interstate and 19 defense highways or the federal aid primary highway system; or 20 21 (ii) 81-1/2 feet if the combination is not traveling on a highway that is part of the national system of 22 interstate and defense highways or the federal aid primary highway 23 24 system. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 25
