A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the approval of insurance companies to provide certain structured settlement annuity contracts. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 142.009, Property Code, is amended by 5 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as 6 follows: 7 In approving an insurance company under Subsection 8 (b) 9 (a)(3), the court may consider whether the company: (1) holds an issuer credit [an industry] rating 10 11 equivalent to a NAIC 1 designation from a national or international 12 [at least two of the following] rating agency that [organizations]: 13 (A) has registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission [A. M. Best Company: A++ or A+]; 14 is designated as a nationally recognized 15 (B) statistical rating organization [Duff & Phelps Credit Rating 16 Company Insurance Company Claims Paying Ability Rating: AA-, AA, 17 AA+, or AAA]; and 18 (C) is on the list of Credit Rating Providers by 19 the Securities Valuation Office of the National Association of 20 21 Insurance Commissioners [Moody's Investors Service Claims Paying 22 Ability Rating: Aa3, Aa2, Aa1, or aaa; or [(D) Standard & Poor's Corporation Insurer 23 Claims-Paying Ability Rating: AA-, AA, AA+, or AAA]; 24

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1 (2) is an affiliate, as that term is described by 2 Section 823.003, Insurance Code, of a liability insurance carrier 3 involved in the suit for which the structured settlement is 4 created; or

5 (3) is connected in any way to a person obligated to 6 fund the structured settlement.

7 (c) The presiding judge may resolve disputes regarding 8 which company will provide the annuity contract for a structured 9 settlement by making a determination that is in the best interests 10 of the beneficiary of the structured settlement, taking into 11 account factors customarily considered in making a determination 12 under Section 141.004, Civil Practice and Remedies Code.

13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
