A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to investigations of abuse or exploitation of an elderly

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 48.002(a)(2) and (3), Human Resources 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (2) "Abuse" means:

person or person with a disability.

- 8 (A) the negligent or wilful infliction of injury,
- 9 unreasonable confinement, intimidation, or cruel punishment with
- 10 resulting physical or emotional harm or pain to an elderly person or
- 11 person with a disability by the person's caretaker, family member,
- 12 or other individual [who has an ongoing relationship with the
- 13 person]; or

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- 14 (B) sexual abuse of an elderly person or person
- 15 with a disability, including any involuntary or nonconsensual
- 16 sexual conduct that would constitute an offense under Section
- 17 21.08, Penal Code (indecent exposure) or Chapter 22, Penal Code
- 18 (assaultive offenses), committed by the person's caretaker, family
- 19 member, or other individual [who has an ongoing relationship with
- 20 the person].
- 21 (3) "Exploitation" means the illegal or improper act
- 22 or process of a caretaker, family member, or other individual [who
- 23 has an ongoing relationship with an elderly person or person with a
- 24 disability that involves using, or attempting to use, the

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- 1 resources of the elderly person or person with a disability,
- 2 including the person's social security number or other identifying
- 3 information, for monetary or personal benefit, profit, or gain
- 4 without the informed consent of the person.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 48.002(c), Human Resources Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the executive
- 8 commissioner by rule may adopt definitions of "abuse," "neglect,"
- 9 and "exploitation," as an alternative to the definitions of those
- 10 terms under Subsection (a), for purposes of conducting an
- 11 investigation under this chapter or Chapter 142, Health and Safety
- 12 Code. The rules:
- 13 (1) may not require an individual to have an ongoing
- 14 relationship with an elderly person or person with a disability for
- 15 the department to conduct an investigation of that individual; and
- 16 (2) must allow the department to conduct an
- 17 investigation of any individual alleged to have committed abuse or
- 18 exploitation.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 48.151, Human Resources Code, is amended
- 20 by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 21 <u>(a-1)</u> The department may investigate an allegation of abuse
- 22 or exploitation committed by any individual, regardless of whether
- 23 that individual has an ongoing relationship with an elderly person
- 24 or a person with a disability.
- 25 SECTION 4. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 26 of this Act, the commissioner of the Department of Family and
- 27 Protective Services shall adopt rules necessary to implement the

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- 1 changes in law made by this Act.
- 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
