Section 51.9685(a)(2), Education Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 "Institution of higher education" has [and "public 7 (2) junior college" have] the meaning [meanings] assigned by Section 8 61.003. 9 SECTION 2. Sections 51.9685(b), (c), and (g), Education 10 11 Code, are amended to read as follows: 12 (b) Except as otherwise provided by Subsection (c), each student enrolled at an institution of higher education in an 13 14 associate or bachelor's degree program or a course for joint high school and junior college credit under Section 130.008 [at an 15 16 institution of higher education] shall file a degree plan with the institution <u>before</u> [not later than] the end of the [second regular] 17 semester or term immediately following the semester or term in 18 which the student earned a cumulative total of 30 [45] or more 19 20 semester credit hours for coursework successfully completed by the 21 student, including transfer courses, international baccalaureate courses, dual credit courses, and any other course for which the 22 23 institution the student attends has awarded the student college course credit, including course credit awarded by examination. 24

1 (c) A student to whom this section applies who begins the 2 student's first semester or term at an institution of higher 3 education with <u>30</u> [45] or more semester credit hours of course 4 credit for courses described by Subsection (b) shall file a degree 5 plan with the institution <u>before</u> [not later than] the end of <u>that</u> 6 [the student's second regular] semester or term [at the 7 institution].

8 (g) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, in 9 consultation with institutions of higher education, <u>shall</u> [may] 10 adopt rules as necessary for the administration of this section<u>,</u> 11 <u>including rules to ensure compliance with this section</u>.

SECTION 3. Section 130.0104(c), Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

14 (c) In complying with the requirements regarding the filing 15 of a degree plan under [Notwithstanding] Section 51.9685, [before the beginning of the regular semester or term immediately following 16 17 the semester or term in which] a student enrolled [successfully completes a cumulative total of 30 or more semester credit hours for 18 coursework] in a multidisciplinary studies associate degree 19 program established under this section [, the student] must meet 20 with an academic advisor to complete a degree plan [, as defined by 21 22 Section 51.9685(a)(1),
] that:

(1) accounts for all remaining credit hours requiredfor the completion of the degree program; and

(A) the student's transition to a particular

H.B. No. 3808 (B) preparations for the student's intended field of study or major at the four-year college or university. SECTION 4. Section 51.9685(c-1), Education Code, is 4 repealed.

5 SECTION 5. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020 6 academic year.

7 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
