A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the funding of certain ship channel improvements. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 56.001(1), Transportation 4 Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 (1)"Board [Commission]" means the Texas Water 7 Development Board [Transportation Commission]. SECTION 2. Sections 56.002(a), (b), and (c), Transportation 8 Code, are amended to read as follows: 9 The ship channel improvement revolving fund is an 10 (a) 11 account in the general revenue fund. The fund is administered by 12 the board [commission]. 13 (b) The following money shall be credited to the fund: 14 (1) money the board [commission] receives as a gift, grant, or donation for a purpose of this chapter; 15 money appropriated to the board [commission] for 16 (2) the purposes of this chapter; 17 money received by the <u>board</u> [commission] for the 18 (3) repayment of a loan made by the program established under Section 19 56.003; and 20 21 (4) interest earned on deposits and investments of the 22 fund. (c) Money in the fund may be appropriated only to the board 23 [commission] for the purposes of administering the fund and the 24

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1 program established under Section 56.003.

2 SECTION 3. Sections 56.003(a) and (b), Transportation Code, 3 are amended to read as follows:

4 (a) The <u>board</u> [commission] by rule shall establish a 5 revolving loan program to use money from the fund to finance 6 qualified projects for navigation districts.

7 (b) To be a qualified project, a project must:

8 (1) deepen or widen a ship channel;

9 (2) be authorized by the United States Congress 10 <u>through the Water Resources Development Act</u>; and

11 (3) meet any other standards provided by <u>board</u>
12 [commission] rule.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
