A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the publication of information regarding the national organ transplant waiting list on the Department of State Health 3 Services' Internet website and certain registrations for the 4 5 anatomical gift registry. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 7 SECTION 1. Section 692A.005(a), Health and Safety Code, is amended to read as follows: 8 9 (a) A donor may make an anatomical gift: on inclusion in the Glenda Dawson Donate 10 (1)11 Life-Texas Registry, as demonstrated by [authorizing] a statement 12 or symbol indicating that the donor has made an anatomical gift [to be] imprinted on the donor's driver's license or identification 13 card in the manner described by Section 521.401, Transportation 14 Code; 15 (2) in a will; 16 during a terminal illness or injury of the donor, 17 (3) by any form of communication addressed to at least two adults, at 18 least one of whom is a disinterested witness; or 19 20 (4) as provided in Subsection (b). 21 SECTION 2. Section 692A.007(a), Health and Safety Code, is 22 amended to read as follows: (a) An individual may refuse to make an anatomical gift of 23 24 the individual's body or part by:

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1 (1) a record signed by: 2 (A) the individual; or 3 (B) subject to Subsection (b), another individual acting at the direction of the individual if the 4 5 individual is physically unable to sign; 6 (2) the individual's will, whether or not the will is 7 admitted to probate or invalidated after the individual's death; 8 [or] 9 (3) any form of communication made by the individual during the individual's terminal illness or injury addressed to at 10 least two adults, at least one of whom is a disinterested witness; 11 12 or (4) for an individual 18 years of age or older, 13 submission of the individual's refusal with the individual's 14 15 application for an original, renewal, corrected, or duplicate driver's license or personal identification certificate, in the 16 17 manner described by Section 521.401, Transportation Code. SECTION 3. Chapter 692A, Health and Safety Code, is amended 18 19 by adding Section 692A.024 to read as follows: Sec. 692A.024. INFORMATION ON NATIONAL WAITING LIST FOR 20 21 ORGAN TRANSPLANT. The department shall prepare and publish on the 22 department's Internet website information on the steps necessary to be placed on the national waiting list for obtaining an organ 23 24 transplant. SECTION 4. Section 502.189(b), Transportation Code, 25 is 26 amended to read as follows:

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(b) The department shall make available for distribution to

each office authorized to issue motor vehicle registrations Donate Life brochures that provide basic donor information in English and Spanish and a contact phone number and e-mail address. The department shall ensure that the question provided in Section <u>521.401(c-1)</u> [<u>521.401(c)(1)(B)</u>] and information on the donor registry Internet website is included with registration renewal notices.

8 SECTION 5. Sections 521.401(c), (c-1), and (e), 9 Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:

10 (c) Donor registry information shall be provided to the department and the Texas Department of Transportation by organ 11 12 procurement organizations, tissue banks, or eye banks, as those terms are defined in Section 692A.002, Health and Safety Code, or by 13 14 the Glenda Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry operated under Chapter 15 692A, Health and Safety Code. The department, with expert input and support from the nonprofit organization administering the Glenda 16 17 Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry, shall:

(1) provide to each applicant for the issuance of an
original, renewal, corrected, or duplicate driver's license or
personal identification certificate who applies in person, by mail,
over the Internet, or by other electronic means:

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(A) if the applicant is younger than 18 years of

23 <u>age</u>:

(i) the opportunity to <u>include a statement</u>
or symbol imprinted [indicate] on the person's driver's license or
personal identification certificate <u>indicating</u> that the person is
willing to make an anatomical gift, in the event of death, in

1 accordance with Section 692A.005, Health and Safety Code; and (ii) [(B)] an opportunity for the person to 2 3 consent to inclusion of the person's information in the statewide Internet-based registry of organ, tissue, and eye donors and 4 release of the information to procurement organizations in the 5 manner provided by Subsection (c-1); and 6 7 (B) if the applicant is 18 years of age or older: 8 (i) the opportunity to refuse inclusion of a statement or symbol imprinted on the person's driver's license or 9 10 personal identification certificate indicating that the person is willing to make an anatomical gift, in the event of death, in 11 12 accordance with Section 692A.005, Health and Safety Code; and (ii) an opportunity for the person to 13 refuse to consent to inclusion of the person's information in the 14 statewide Internet-based registry of organ, tissue, and eye donors 15 and release of the information to procurement organizations in the 16 manner provided by Subsection (c-1); and 17 (2) provide a means to distribute donor registry 18 19 information to interested individuals in each office authorized to 20 issue driver's licenses or personal identification certificates. (c-1) The department shall: 21 22 (1)for each applicant younger than 18 years of age: (A) specifically ask the [each] applicant only 23 24 the question, "Would you like to register as an organ donor?"; and (B) [(2)] if 25 the applicant responds 26 affirmatively to the question asked under Paragraph (A) [Subdivision (1)], provide the person's name, date of birth, 27

driver's license number, most recent address, and other information needed for identification purposes at the time of donation to the nonprofit organization contracted to maintain the statewide donor registry under Section 692A.020, Health and Safety Code, for inclusion in the registry; and

6 (2) for each applicant who is 18 years of age or older: 7 (A) specifically ask the applicant the question, 8 "Would you like to refuse to join the organ donor registry?" and 9 state, "By answering 'no' to the previous question or not answering 10 the previous question, you consent to join the organ donor registry 11 and for your information to be included in the registry."; and 12 (B) if the applicant does not affirmatively

12 (B) if the applicant does not affirmatively 13 refuse to be included in the registry under Paragraph (A), provide 14 the person's name, date of birth, driver's license number, most 15 recent address, and other information needed for identification 16 purposes at the time of donation to the nonprofit organization 17 contracted to maintain the statewide donor registry under Section 18 692A.020, Health and Safety Code, for inclusion in the registry.

(e) The department shall distribute at all field offices Donate Life brochures that provide basic donation information in English and Spanish and include a contact phone number and e-mail address. The department shall include the <u>questions</u> [question] required under Subsection (c-1) [(c)(1)(B)] and information on the donor registry Internet website in renewal notices.

25 SECTION 6. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 26 a driver's license or personal identification certificate for which 27 an application is submitted on or after the effective date of this

1 Act. A driver's license or personal identification certificate for 2 which an application was submitted before the effective date of 3 this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the 4 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for 5 that purpose.

6 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
