- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 2157.007, Government
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2157.007. [CONSIDERATION OF] CLOUD COMPUTING SERVICE
- 8 [PURCHASE].
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 2157.007(b), Government Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 (b) A state agency shall ensure [consider cloud computing
- 12 service options, including any security benefits and cost savings
- 13 associated with purchasing those service options from a cloud
- 14 computing service provider and from a statewide technology center
- 15 established by the department], when making purchases for an
- 16 <u>automated information system or</u> a major information resources
- 17 project under Section 2054.118, that the system or project is
- 18 capable of being deployed and run on cloud computing services.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 2157.007, Government Code, as amended by
- 20 this Act, applies only with respect to a purchase made by a state
- 21 agency on or after the effective date of this Act. A purchase made
- 22 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 23 effect on the date the purchase was made, and the former law is
- 24 continued in effect for that purpose.
