11	million shall order that trustees of the district are to be elected
12	from single-member trustee districts if the district, in October
13	2017, had:
14	(1) a student enrollment of more than 50,000;
15	(2) a student enrollment of more than 35,000 but less
16	than 40,000; or
17	(3) a student enrollment of more than 24,000 but less
18	than 28,000.

- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
