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## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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1	AN ACT
2	relating to a self-employment assistance program for unemployed
3	individuals.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 207.021(a), Labor Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(a) Except as provided by <u>Chapters</u> [ <del>Chapter</del> ] 215 <u>and 216</u> , ar
8	unemployed individual is eligible to receive benefits for a benefit
9	period if the individual:
10	(1) has registered for work at an employment office
11	and has continued to report to the employment office as required by
12	rules adopted by the commission;
13	(2) has made a claim for benefits under Section
14	208.001;
15	(3) is able to work;
16	(4) is available for work;
17	(5) is actively seeking work in accordance with rules
18	adopted by the commission;
19	(6) for the individual's base period, has benefit wage

individual's benefit amount;

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credits:

(A) in at least two calendar quarters; and

(7) after the beginning date of the individual's most

in an amount not less than 37 times the

- 1 recent prior benefit year, if applicable, earned wages in an amount
- 2 equal to not less than six times the individual's benefit amount;
- 3 (8) has been totally or partially unemployed for a
- 4 waiting period of at least seven consecutive days; and
- 5 (9) participates in reemployment services, such as a
- 6 job search assistance service, if the individual has been
- 7 determined, according to a profiling system established by the
- 8 commission, to be likely to exhaust eligibility for regular
- 9 benefits and to need those services to obtain new employment,
- 10 unless:
- 11 (A) the individual has completed participation
- 12 in such a service; or
- 13 (B) there is reasonable cause, as determined by
- 14 the commission, for the individual's failure to participate in
- 15 those services.
- 16 SECTION 2. Subtitle A, Title 4, Labor Code, is amended by
- 17 adding Chapter 216 to read as follows:
- 18 CHAPTER 216. SELF-EMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
- 19 Sec. 216.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 20 (1) "Self-employment activity" means a
- 21 <u>commission-approved activity that furthers an individual's goal to</u>
- 22 <u>start a business.</u>
- 23 (2) "Self-employment assistance allowance" means an
- 24 unemployment compensation benefit payable to an individual engaged
- 25 in a self-employment activity.
- Sec. 216.002. SELF-EMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM. (a) The
- 27 commission shall establish and administer a self-employment

- 1 assistance program to provide financial assistance to an eligible
- 2 individual seeking to start a business.
- 3 (b) Subject to the requirements of this chapter, an
- 4 individual participating in the self-employment assistance program
- 5 may receive a self-employment assistance allowance in lieu of and
- 6 in an amount equal to the individual's benefit amount.
- 7 (c) Any self-employment assistance allowance payments made
- 8 to an individual under this chapter are included for purposes of
- 9 determining whether the individual has received the maximum amount
- 10 of benefits for which the individual is eligible as provided by
- 11 Section 207.005.
- 12 Sec. 216.003. COMMISSION DUTIES. (a) The commission by
- 13 rule shall establish eligibility criteria for an individual
- 14 participating in the self-employment assistance program.
- 15 (b) The commission shall establish weekly self-employment
- 16 activity requirements for an individual to qualify to receive a
- 17 self-employment assistance allowance.
- 18 (c) The commission shall adopt rules as necessary to comply
- 19 with any federal requirement applicable to a self-employment
- 20 assistance program.
- Sec. 216.004. ELIGIBILITY. (a) An individual is eligible
- 22 to participate in the self-employment assistance program if the
- 23 individual:
- 24 (1) is likely to exhaust the individual's regular
- 25 benefits; and
- 26 (2) meets any eligibility criteria established by the
- 27 commission.

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- 1 (b) An individual is eligible to receive a self-employment
- 2 assistance allowance for a week in which the individual is engaged
- 3 <u>in a self-employment activity and meets all the eligibility</u>
- 4 requirements under Chapter 207 to receive benefits other than the
- 5 requirements of Sections 207.021(a)(4) and (5).
- 6 Sec. 216.005. LIMITATION ON PARTICIPATION. At any time,
- 7 the aggregate number of individuals receiving self-employment
- 8 assistance allowances may not exceed five percent of the number of
- 9 individuals receiving regular benefits under this subtitle.
- SECTION 3. Not later than June 30, 2020, the Texas Workforce
- 11 Commission shall adopt the rules required by Chapter 216, Labor
- 12 Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
