4	SECTION 1. Chapter 193, Health and Safety Code, is amended
5	by adding Section 193.0025 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 193.0025. PROCESS FOR EXPEDITED DEATH CERTIFICATES FOR
7	RELIGIOUS PURPOSES. (a) The executive commissioner by rule shall
8	establish a process by which an individual may submit a written
9	request to the person required to file a death certificate under
10	Section 193.002 for the person to expedite the completion of a
11	decedent's death certificate if the requestor demonstrates that:
12	(1) the expedited completion is necessary for
13	religious purposes; and
14	(2) the requestor is authorized to receive the
15	certificate.
16	(b) The process must seek to enable a person required to
17	file a death certificate who receives a request under Subsection
18	(a) to issue a copy of a decedent's death certificate to the
19	requestor not later than 24 hours after the time the person receives
20	the request, provided an inquest will not be conducted for the
21	decedent.
22	SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
23	of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
24	Services Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement
