## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a supplemental payment for certain retirees of the
- 3 Teacher Retirement System of Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) Subject to Section 821.006, Government
- 6 Code, the Teacher Retirement System of Texas shall make a one-time
- 7 supplemental payment of a retirement or death benefit, as provided
- 8 by this section.
- 9 (b) The supplemental payment is payable in September 2019
- 10 and, to the extent practicable, on a date or dates that coincide
- 11 with the regular annuity payment payable to each eligible
- 12 annuitant.
- 13 (c) The amount of the supplemental payment is equal to the
- 14 lesser of:
- 15 (1) \$2,400; or
- 16 (2) the gross amount of the regular annuity payment to
- 17 which the eligible annuitant is otherwise entitled for the month of
- 18 August 2019.
- 19 (d) The supplemental payment is payable without regard to
- 20 any forfeiture of benefits under Section 824.601, Government Code.
- 21 The Teacher Retirement System of Texas shall make applicable tax
- 22 withholding and other legally required deductions before
- 23 disbursing the supplemental payment. A supplemental payment under
- 24 this section is in addition to and not in lieu of the regular

- 1 monthly annuity payment to which the eligible annuitant is
- 2 otherwise entitled.
- 3 (e) Subject to Subsection (f) of this section, to be
- 4 eligible for the supplemental payment, a person must be, for the
- 5 month of August 2019, and disregarding any forfeiture of benefits
- 6 under Section 824.601, Government Code, an annuitant eligible to
- 7 receive:
- 8 (1) a standard retirement annuity payment;
- 9 (2) an optional retirement annuity payment as either a
- 10 retiree or beneficiary;
- 11 (3) a life annuity payment under Section
- 12 824.402(a)(4), Government Code;
- 13 (4) an annuity for a guaranteed period of 60 months
- 14 under Section 824.402(a)(3), Government Code; or
- 15 (5) an alternate payee annuity payment under Section
- 16 804.005, Government Code.
- 17 (f) If the annuitant is a retiree or a beneficiary under an
- 18 optional retirement payment plan, to be eligible for the
- 19 supplemental payment, the effective date of the retirement of the
- 20 member of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas must have been on
- 21 or before August 31, 2015. If the annuitant is a beneficiary under
- 22 Section 824.402(a)(3) or (4), Government Code, to be eligible for
- 23 the supplemental payment, the date of death of the member of the
- 24 retirement system must have been on or before August 31, 2015. The
- 25 supplemental payment shall be made to an alternate payee who is an
- 26 annuitant under Section 804.005, Government Code, only if the
- 27 annuity payment to the alternate payee commenced on or before

- 1 August 31, 2015. The supplemental payment is in addition to the
- 2 guaranteed number of payments under Section 824.204(c)(3) or (4),
- 3 824.308(c)(3) or (4), or 824.402(a)(3), Government Code, and may
- 4 not be counted as one of the guaranteed monthly payments.
- 5 (g) The supplemental payment does not apply to payments
- 6 under:
- 7 (1) Section 824.304(a), Government Code, relating to
- 8 disability retirees with less than 10 years of service credit;
- 9 (2) Section 824.804(b), Government Code, relating to
- 10 participants in the deferred retirement option plan with regard to
- 11 payments from their deferred retirement option plan accounts;
- 12 (3) Section 824.501(a), Government Code, relating to
- 13 retiree survivor beneficiaries who receive a survivor annuity in an
- 14 amount fixed by statute; or
- 15 (4) Section 824.404(a), Government Code, relating to
- 16 active member survivor beneficiaries who receive a survivor annuity
- 17 in an amount fixed by statute.
- 18 (h) Except as provided by this section, the board of
- 19 trustees of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas shall determine
- 20 the eligibility for and the amount and timing of a supplemental
- 21 payment and the manner in which the payment is made.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
