PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN CONTINGENT 16 FEE CONTRACTS. A local government that is a public agency as defined by 17 Section 30.003 may not enter into a contingent fee contract as 18 defined by Section 2254.101, Government Code, for legal services 19 associated with a civil suit brought under this subchapter. 20 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a civil suit under Subchapter H, Chapter 7, Water Code, that is 22 23 filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A civil suit filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in 24

2 continued in effect for that purpose.
