11	SECTION 2. Section 681.006(a), Transportation Code, is
12	amended to read as follows:

- 1 the vehicle's front windshield a disabled parking placard; or
- 2 (2) in a parking space designated as van-only under

- 4 (A) the requirements of Subdivision (1) are met;

- 7 SECTION 3. Section 681.009(b), Transportation Code, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 (b) A political subdivision must designate a parking space
- 10 or area by conforming to the standards and specifications adopted
- 11 by the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation under Section
- 12 469.052, Government Code [5(i), Article 9102, Revised Statutes],
- 13 relating to the identification and dimensions of parking spaces for
- 14 persons with disabilities. A person who owns or controls private
- 15 property used for parking may designate a parking space or area
- 16 without conforming to those standards and specifications, unless
- 17 required to conform by law.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
