- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. STUDY OF IMPACT OF STATE EDUCATIONAL MANDATES ON
- 6 SCHOOL DISTRICTS. (a) In this section, "state educational mandate"
- 7 means a statutory provision or a Texas Education Agency rule
- 8 adopted under that provision the implementation of which requires
- 9 an expenditure by a school district that would not have been
- 10 required in the absence of the statutory provision or the rule
- 11 adopted under that provision.
- 12 (b) The Legislative Budget Board, in coordination with the
- 13 Texas Education Agency, shall conduct a study regarding the effect
- 14 of state educational mandates on school districts. The study must
- 15 include:
- 16 (1) a cost-benefit analysis on the impact of school
- 17 district compliance with state educational mandates, including a
- 18 comparison of:
- 19 (A) the direct and indirect costs incurred by a
- 20 school district in complying with a state educational mandate; and
- 21 (B) the amount of funds received by the district
- 22 from the state to comply with the mandate;
- 23 (2) a list of all state educational mandates for which
- 24 the legislature has not appropriated or otherwise provided full

- 1 payment or reimbursement that results in expenditures accrued by a
- 2 school district to comply with the state educational mandate; and
- 3 (3) recommendations to reduce the burden of state
- 4 educational mandates on school districts, including proposals for
- 5 legislative action.
- 6 SECTION 2. REPORT. Not later than December 31, 2020, the
- 7 Legislative Budget Board shall deliver a report of the board's
- 8 findings and recommendations to the legislature.
- 9 SECTION 3. EXPIRATION. This Act expires February 1, 2021.
- 10 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 11 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 12 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 13 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 14 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
