## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the compensation of an assistant county auditor.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 84.021, Local Government Code, is amended by amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection

- 6 (b-1) to read as follows:

  7 (a) From time to time the county auditor may certify to the

  8 district judges a list stating the number of assistants to be

  9 appointed and [7] the name, duties, qualifications, and experience

  10 of each appointee [7 and the salary to be paid each appointee]. The
- 12 the appointment of the assistants and after inquiry concerning the

district judges, after careful consideration of the application for

- 13 appointees' qualifications  $\underline{\mathrm{and}}\left[ {m{ au}} \right]$  the positions sought to be
- 14 filled, [and the reasonableness of the requested salaries,] shall
- 15 prepare a list of the appointees that the judges approve [and the
- 16 salary to be paid each]. The judges shall certify this list to the
- 17 commissioners court, which shall order  $[\frac{1}{2}]$  salaries to be paid on
- 18 the performance of services and shall appropriate an adequate
- 19 amount of money for this purpose.
- 20 (b) If an emergency exists, the county auditor shall
- 21 recommend the appointment of temporary assistants, and [after a
- 22 hearing held in accordance with Section 152.905, ] the district
- 23 judges shall determine the number[ , salaries, ] and duration of
- 24 employment of the assistants.

- 1 (b-1) The commissioners court shall determine the salary of
- 2 an assistant auditor appointed under Subsection (a) or (b).
- 3 SECTION 2. Sections 152.905(a), (b), and (d), Local
- 4 Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) This section applies only to the compensation of the
- 6 county auditor[, assistant auditors,] and court reporters.
- 7 (b) Before setting the amount of annual compensation of the
- 8 county auditor[, assistant auditors,] and court reporters, the
- 9 district judge or judges shall hold a public hearing on the matter
- 10 at which parties in interest and citizens have an opportunity to be
- 11 heard.
- 12 (d) At the hearing, the district judge or judges shall set
- 13 the amount of compensation of the county auditor[, assistant
- 14 auditors, and court reporters considered at the hearing. The vote
- 15 must be recorded, transcribed, and maintained as a public record.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 17 an assistant county auditor appointed on or after the effective
- 18 date of this Act. An assistant county auditor appointed before the
- 19 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect
- 20 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 21 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
