5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 487.105, Health and Safety Code, is

7 amended by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:

8 <u>(c-1)</u> The criteria established under Subsection (c) must

provide that an individual's conviction of or placement on deferred

10 adjudication community supervision for an offense involving the

11 possession of marihuana that was punishable as a misdemeanor does

12 not prevent the individual from passing the criminal history

13 background check for the purposes of this section.

14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section

15 487.105, Health and Safety Code, applies to an individual's

16 eligibility for employment with a dispensing organization based on

17 a criminal history background check conducted on or after the

18 effective date of this Act, regardless of when a conviction

19 reported as part of the individual's criminal history occurred.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
