## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a program administered by the Railroad Commission of 3 Texas to provide grants to promote pipeline emergency preparedness; authorizing a fee. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 81, Natural Resources 6 7 Code, is amended by adding Section 81.0715 to read as follows: Sec. 81.0715. EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS FEES AND GRANTS. (a) 8 The commission by rule shall establish pipeline emergency 9 preparedness fees to be assessed for permits or registrations for 10 pipelines under the jurisdiction of the commission's pipeline 11 safety and regulatory program. 12 (b) Fees collected under this section shall be deposited to 13 the credit of a dedicated account in the general revenue fund. 14 Money in the account may be appropriated only for the purposes of 15 16 the grant program established by this section and associated administrative expenses. 17 (c) The commission shall establish a grant program to 18 provide funding for emergency preparedness expenses, such as the 19 creation of evacuation plans for pipeline-related emergencies, 20 such as spills or leaks. 21 22 (d) The commission may provide a grant under this section 23 only to a political subdivision that: (1) provides emergency services to respond 24 to

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1	pipeline-related emergencies; and
2	(2) is located within five miles of a pipeline.
3	(e) The commission may establish the fees in an amount
4	necessary to provide a reasonable amount of funding for the grant
5	program established by this section, based on emergency
6	preparedness expenses typically required by political subdivisions
7	for pipeline-related emergencies.
8	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
