1 regardless of the person's refusal; or

2 (3) the person is a ward who is 18 years of age or older 3 and the guardian of the person of the ward consents to the 4 administration of psychoactive medication regardless of the ward's 5 expressed preferences regarding treatment with psychoactive 6 medication.

7 SECTION 2. Section 574.029, Health and Safety Code, as 8 added by this Act, applies only to a person for whom a motion for 9 court-ordered inpatient mental health services is granted on or 10 after the effective date of this Act.
