- 2 relating to the licensing of certain child-care facilities that

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Human Resources Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 42.0539 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 42.0539. RESIDENTIAL DETENTION FACILITIES.
- 8 Notwithstanding any other law, the commission shall:
- 9 <u>(1) license each child-care facility, that is operated</u>
- 10 by or under a contract with United States Immigration and Customs
- 11 Enforcement or the United States Department of Health and Human
- 12 <u>Services to enforce federal immigration laws and that detains</u>
- 13 <u>unaccompanied children</u>, in the same manner as the commission
- 14 licenses a residential child-care facility under this chapter; and
- 15 (2) require the facility to comply with the same
- 16 requirements, including minimum standards, applicable to a
- 17 residential child-care facility.
- 18 SECTION 2. A child-care facility subject to Section
- 19 42.0539, Human Resources Code, as added by this Act, must obtain the
- 20 required license not later than December 1, 2019.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
