15	governing body of a municipality that has applied for or received
16	International Dark Sky Community designation by ordinance may
17	regulate the installation and use of outdoor lighting in the
18	municipality and municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction.
19	(b) A municipality may only regulate outdoor lighting
20	constructed or renovated on or after the effective date of an
21	ordinance adopted under Subsection (a).

23	municipality may sue in any court to enjoin a violation of an
