3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 352, Tax Code, is amended by adding
5	section 352.114 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 352.114. USE OF REVENUE; CERTAIN COUNTIES THAT BORDER
7	MEXICO AND CONTAIN A NATIONAL PARK.
8	(a) Other provisions of this Chapter notwithstanding, if a
9	National Park with more than 400,000 acres located within a County
10	described by subsection 352.002(a)(14) closes or if the National
11	Park's essential visitor operations are significantly curtailed
12	for more than three consecutive days due to a lack of federal
13	appropriation of funding or due to an emergency, the County may use
14	hotel occupancy tax revenues as follows during the closure of the
15	National Park:
16	(1) To provide for the supplemental collection of
17	waste, sanitation, and to protect the health, safety, and welfare
18	of Park visitors; and
19	(2) To provide supplemental guidance and interpretive
20	services for Park visitors.
21	(b) The County may not continue to expend revenue for

more than 60 days in that fiscal year.

(c) The County may enter into an agreement with a federal

- 2 (d) The County may not use hotel tax revenue under this
- 3 <u>Section in an amount that exceeds annual area hotel revenue</u>
- 4 <u>attributable to visitors to the National Park.</u>
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
