- 2 relating to the possession of condemned property by the condemnor
- 3 pending the results of further litigation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.021, Property Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a) and (c) and adding Subsections (e) and (f)
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) After the special commissioners have made an award in a
- 9 condemnation proceeding, except as provided by Subsection (c) and
- 10 subject to Subsection (e) [of this section], the condemnor may take
- 11 possession of the condemned property pending the results of further
- 12 litigation if the condemnor, not later than the seventh day after
- 13 <u>the date of the commissioners' award</u>:
- 14 (1) pays to the property owner the amount of damages
- 15 and costs awarded by the special commissioners or deposits that
- 16 amount of money with the court subject to the order of the property
- 17 owner;
- 18 (2) deposits with the court either the amount of money
- 19 awarded by the special commissioners as damages or a surety bond in
- 20 the same amount issued by a surety company qualified to do business
- 21 in this state, conditioned to secure the payment of an award of
- 22 damages by the court in excess of the award of the special
- 23 commissioners; and
- 24 (3) executes a bond that has two or more good and

- 1 solvent sureties approved by the judge of the court in which the
- 2 proceeding is pending and conditioned to secure the payment of
- 3 additional costs that may be awarded to the property owner by the
- 4 trial court or on appeal.
- 5 (c) This state, a county, or a municipal corporation or an
- 6 irrigation, water improvement, or water power control district
- 7 created under legal authority:
- 8 <u>(1) may take possession under this section of</u>
- 9 condemned property pending the results of further litigation, if
- 10 the condemnor satisfies the requirements of Subsection (a)(1);
- 11 (2) is not required to deposit a bond or the amount
- 12 equal to the award of damages under Subsections (a)(2)
- 13 [Subdivisions (2)] and (3) [of Subsection (a)]; and
- is not subject to Subsection (e)
- 15 (e) A condemnor may not take possession under this section
- 16 of condemned property pending the results of further litigation
- 17 before the 180th day after the date of the commissioners' award.
- 18 (f) This section may not be construed to prohibit an
- 19 agreement approved by the court between a property owner and a
- 20 condemnor that allows immediate possession of the condemned
- 21 property by the condemnor.
- 22 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a
- 23 condemnation proceeding for which a petition is filed on or after
- 24 the effective date of this Act. A condemnation proceeding for which
- 25 a petition is filed before the effective date of this Act is
- 26 governed by the law in effect on the date the petition is filed, and
- 27 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
