- 6 SECTION 1. Section 130.306, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read
- 8 as follows:
- 9 (b) Except as otherwise provided by this section
- 10 [Subsection (a)], a public junior college offering a baccalaureate
- 11 degree program under this subchapter may not offer more than three
- 12 baccalaureate degree programs at any time.
- 13 (d) A public junior college offering a baccalaureate degree
- 14 program under this subchapter that is located in a county with a
- 15 population of more than 1,700,000 based on United States Census
- 16 2010 data and that is located within 180 miles of the Texas-Mexico
- 17 border may not offer more than five baccalaureate degree programs
- 18 at any time.
- (e) At any time, South Texas College may not offer more than
- 20 six baccalaureate degree programs under this subchapter.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
