A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to authorization by the Texas Higher Education 3 Coordinating Board for certain public junior colleges to offer 4 baccalaureate degree programs.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Section 130.306, Education Code, is amended by

7 amending subsection (b) and adding subsection (d) to read as 8 follows:

9 (b) Except as provided by Subsection<u>s</u> (a) <u>and (d)</u>, a public 10 junior college offering a baccalaureate degree program under this 11 subchapter may not offer more than three baccalaureate degree 12 programs at any time.

13 (d) A public junior college offering a baccalaureate degree 14 program under this subchapter that is located in a county with a 15 population of more than 1,800,000 based on United States Census 16 2010 data and that is located within 180 miles of the Texas-Mexico 17 border may not offer more than six baccalaureate degree programs at 18 any time.

19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
