- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 261.302, Family Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsections (b-2) and (b-3) to read as follows:
- (b-2) The department may not interview the child at the 8
- 9 child's school as part of an investigation unless:
- (1) the child's parent or other person having custody 10
- 11 of the child consents in writing to the interview; or
- 12 (2) the department obtains a court order for the
- interview. 13

- 14 (b-3) This section does not limit the authority of a law
- enforcement agency to perform its duties under any other law. 15
- SECTION 2. Section 261.302, Family Code, as amended by this 16
- Act, applies only to an investigation of a report of abuse or 17
- neglect of a child initiated by the Department of Family and 18
- Protective Services on or after the effective date of this Act. An 19
- 20 investigation initiated by the department before that date is
- governed by the law in effect on the date the investigation was 21
- initiated, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 22
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
