 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to photographs on certain state-issued identification  
 1-18 cards.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 411.179(a), Government Code, is amended  
 1-21 to read as follows:

1-22 (a) The department by rule shall adopt the form of the  
 1-23 license. A license must include:

1-24 (1) a number assigned to the license holder by the  
 1-25 department;

1-26 (2) a statement of the period for which the license is  
 1-27 effective;

1-28 (3) a ~~color~~ photograph of the license holder;

1-29 (4) the license holder's full name, date of birth, hair  
 1-30 and eye color, height, weight, and signature;

1-31 (5) the license holder's residence address or, as  
 1-32 provided by Subsection (d), the street address of the courthouse in  
 1-33 which the license holder or license holder's spouse serves as a  
 1-34 federal judge or the license holder serves as a state judge;

1-35 (6) the number of a driver's license or an  
 1-36 identification certificate issued to the license holder by the  
 1-37 department; and

1-38 (7) the designation "VETERAN" if required under  
 1-39 Subsection (e).

1-40 SECTION 2. Section 1702.232(c), Occupations Code, is  
 1-41 amended to read as follows:

1-42 (c) The pocket card must:

1-43 (1) state the name of the registrant;

1-44 (2) contain a ~~color~~ photograph, affixed to the  
 1-45 pocket card by the board at the time the card is issued, and the  
 1-46 signature of the registrant;

1-47 (3) state the date the card was issued and the card's  
 1-48 expiration date; and

1-49 (4) state each endorsement held by the registrant and  
 1-50 the date the endorsement expires.

1-51 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
