A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to imposing an additional fee for the registration of an alternatively fueled vehicle. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 502.198(a), Transportation Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 (a) Except as provided by Sections 502.058, 502.060, 7 502.1911, 502.192, 502.356, [and] 502.357, and 502.360 and 8 Subchapter H, this section applies to all fees collected by a county 9 assessor-collector under this chapter. 10 11 SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 502, Transportation Code, 12 is amended by adding Section 502.360 to read as follows: Sec. 502.360. ADDITIONAL FEE FOR ALTERNATIVELY FUELED 13 VEHICLES. (a) In this section, "alternatively fueled vehicle" has 14 the meaning assigned by Section 502.004. 15 16 (b) In addition to other fees authorized under this chapter, at the time of application for registration or renewal of 17 registration of an alternatively fueled vehicle, the applicant 18 shall pay an additional fee as determined by the department under 19 Subsection (c). 20 21 (c) The department shall, for each class of vehicle registered under this chapter: 22 23 (1) develop a methodology for determining the fee under Subsection (b) that calculates the fee based on the average 24

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1	annual amount of taxes imposed under Chapter 162, Tax Code, that an
2	alternatively fueled vehicle of that class of vehicle would pay if
3	the vehicle operated only on gasoline or diesel fuel; and
4	(2) set the fee in an amount of not less than 75
5	percent and not more than 85 percent of the amount calculated under
6	Subdivision (1).
7	(d) The department shall review and update each fee
8	calculated under Subsection (c) at least once every five years.
9	(e) An alternatively fueled vehicle that may be registered
10	under this chapter without payment of a registration fee may be
11	registered without payment of the additional fee.
12	(f) The additional fee shall be collected for an
13	alternatively fueled vehicle when other fees imposed under this
14	chapter are collected.
15	(g) Fees collected under this section shall be deposited to
16	the credit of the state highway fund.
17	(h) The board shall adopt rules necessary to administer
18	registration for an alternatively fueled vehicle under this
19	section.
20	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
