- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) The Health and Human Services Commission
- shall conduct a study on state and local regulation of group homes. 6

- identify and evaluate state laws relating to the 8

- analyze the procedures for filing complaints 16 (2)
- against group homes and make recommendations to expedite complaint 17

- (3) analyze complaints filed against group homes after 19

- 21 analyze the enforcement authority over group homes
- 22 granted to state and local governmental agencies, including the
- authority of counties and municipalities to enforce boarding home 23
- 24 regulations;

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- 1 (5) recommend whether additional state and local
- 2 governmental enforcement authority over group homes is needed;
- 3 (6) recommend processes to expedite the licensing of
- 4 and regulatory procedures for group homes;
- 5 (7) determine whether new categories of group homes
- 6 should be licensed or regulated by state or local governmental

- 8 (8) discuss and recommend methods for identifying

- 15 (c) Not later than December 1, 2020, the Health and Human
- 16 Services Commission shall prepare a written or electronic report
- 17 that includes a summary of the results of the study conducted under
- 18 this section and any legislative recommendations based on the study
- 19 and submit the report to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker
- 20 of the house of representatives, and members of the standing
- 21 committees of the senate and the house of representatives with
- 22 jurisdiction over the Health and Human Services Commission.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
