- 7 (f) Instead of requiring the defendant to work a specified
- 8 number of hours at one or more community service projects under
- 9 Subsection (a), the judge may order a defendant to make a specified
- 10 donation to:
- 11 (1) a nonprofit food bank or food pantry in the
- 12 community in which the defendant resides;
- 13 (2) a charitable organization engaged primarily in
- 14 performing charitable functions [for veterans] in the community in
- 15 which the defendant resides for defendants under community
- 16 supervision or for veterans; or
- 17 (3) in a county with a population of less than 50,000,
- 18 another nonprofit organization that:
- 19 (A) is exempt from taxation under Section 501(a)
- 20 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 because it is listed in Section
- 21 501(c)(3) of that code; and
- 22 (B) provides services or assistance to needy
- 23 individuals and families in the community in which the defendant
- 24 resides.
