- 6 SECTION 1. Section 375.112(a), Local Government Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) An improvement project or services provided by the
- 9 district may include the construction, acquisition, improvement,
- 10 relocation, operation, maintenance, or provision of:
- 11 (1) landscaping; lighting, banners, and signs;
- 12 streets and sidewalks; pedestrian skywalks, crosswalks, and
- 13 tunnels; seawalls; marinas; drainage and navigation improvements;
- 14 pedestrian malls; solid waste, water, sewer, and power facilities,
- 15 including electrical, gas, steam, cogeneration, and chilled water
- 16 facilities; parks, plazas, lakes, rivers, bayous, ponds, and
- 17 recreation and scenic areas; <u>public education facilities;</u> historic
- 18 areas; fountains; works of art; off-street parking facilities, bus
- 19 terminals, heliports, and mass transit systems; theatres, studios,
- 20 exhibition halls, production facilities and ancillary facilities
- 21 in support of the foregoing; and the cost of any demolition in
- 22 connection with providing any of the improvement projects;
- 23 (2) other improvements similar to those described in
- 24 Subdivision (1);

- 1 (3) the acquisition of real property or any interest
- 2 in real property in connection with an improvement, project, or
- 3 services authorized by this chapter, Chapter 54, Water Code, or
- 4 Chapter 365 or 441, Transportation Code;
- 5 (4) special supplemental services for advertising,
- 6 economic development, promoting the area in the district, health
- 7 and sanitation, public safety, public education, maintenance,
- 8 security, business recruitment, development, elimination or relief
- 9 of traffic congestion, recreation, and cultural enhancement; and
- 10 (5) expenses incurred in the establishment,
- 11 administration, maintenance, and operation of the district or any
- 12 of its improvements, projects, or services.
