A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the legalization of certain cannabidiol. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Sections 481.002(5) and (26), Health and Safety 4 5 Code, are amended to read as follows: (5) "Controlled substance" means 6 а substance, 7 including a drug, an adulterant, and a dilutant, listed in Schedules I through V or Penalty Group 1, 1-A, 2, 2-A, 3, or 4. The 8 9 term includes the aggregate weight of any mixture, solution, or other substance containing a controlled substance. The term does 10 not include cannabidiol included in the definition of "hemp" 11 provided by Section 297A, Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946 (7 12 U.S.C. Section 16390). 13 14 (26) "Marihuana" means the plant Cannabis sativa L., whether growing or not, the seeds of that plant, and every compound, 15 16 manufacture, salt, derivative, mixture, or preparation of that plant or its seeds. The term does not include: 17 18 (A) the resin extracted from a part of the plant a compound, manufacture, salt, derivative, mixture, or 19 or preparation of the resin; 20 21 (B) the mature stalks of the plant or fiber produced from the stalks; 22

(C) oil or cake made from the seeds of the plant;
(D) a compound, manufacture, salt, derivative,

No. 4276 mixture, or preparation of the mature stalks, fiber, oil, or cake; 1 [or] 2 3 (E) the sterilized seeds of the plant that are 4 incapable of beginning germination; or (F) cannabidiol included in the definition of 5 6 "hemp" provided by Section 297A, Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946 7 (7 U.S.C. Section 16390). SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11

12 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
