10	student competitiveness in the labor market, the commissioner may
11	create career and technical credentials or certificates that may be
12	earned by a public high school student through a career and
13	technology education program.
14	(b) A credential or certificate created under this section
15	must:
16	(1) be aligned with state and regional workforce needs
17	in the applicable field; and
18	(2) serve as an entry point for employment or a bridge
19	to postsecondary education in the applicable field.
20	(c) The commissioner may consult with relevant stakeholders
21	in creating credentials or certificates under this section.
22	(d) The agency shall post on the agency's Internet website
23	information regarding any credentials or certificates created by
24	the commissioner under this section.
