## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to Medicaid coverage of doula services.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 32.024, Human Resources Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Subsection (nn) to read as follows:
- 6 (nn) The commission shall provide medical assistance
- 7 reimbursement for services provided by a doula, including
- 8 childbirth education and emotional and physical support provided
- 9 during pregnancy, labor, birth, and the postpartum period. The
- 10 executive commissioner by rule shall determine the doula services
- 11 to be covered and any doula certification requirements.
- 12 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2019, the executive
- 13 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 14 adopt the rules necessary to implement Section 32.024(nn), Human
- 15 Resources Code, as added by this Act.
- 16 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 17 a state agency determines that an additional waiver or additional
- 18 authorization from a federal agency is necessary for implementation
- 19 of that provision, the agency affected by the provision shall
- 20 request the waiver or authorization and may delay implementing that
- 21 provision until the waiver or authorization is granted.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
