A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to an allotment under the public school finance system for 3 certain students whose parent or legal guardian has been 4 incarcerated. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Education Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 42.169 to read as follows: 8 Sec. 42.169. ALLOTMENT FOR STUDENTS WITH INCARCERATED PARENT. For each student who has a parent or legal guardian who has 9 been incarcerated in a penal institution, as defined by Section 10 1.07, Penal Code, during the school year for which the allotment is 11 12 provided, a school district is entitled to an annual allotment equal to the district's adjusted basic allotment multiplied by 1.1. 13 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
