A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1
2 relating to an allotment under the public school finance system for
3 certain students whose parent or legal guardian has been
4 incarcerated.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Education Code, is
7 amended by adding Section 42.169 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 42.169. ALLOTMENT FOR STUDENTS WITH INCARCERATED
9 PARENT. For each student who has a parent or legal guardian who has
10 been incarcerated in a penal institution, as defined by Section
11 1.07, Penal Code, during the school year for which the allotment is
12 provided, a school district is entitled to an annual allotment
13 equal to the district's adjusted basic allotment multiplied by 1.1.

14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
