Section 7.010(b) and (c), Education Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 (b) Each school district, open-enrollment charter school, 7 and institution of higher education shall participate in an 8 9 electronic student records system that satisfies standards approved by the commissioner of education and the commissioner of 10 11 higher education. The commissioner of education and the 12 commissioner of higher education may specify an approved format for submission of electronic student records. 13 14 (c) The electronic student records system must permit an authorized state or district official or an 15 authorized representative of an institution of higher education 16 to electronically transfer student transcripts to and from an 17 18 educational institution in which the student is enrolled, to extract data elements from [and retrieve] student transcripts in an 19 efficient and effective manner, and to provide those data elements 20 for import into an electronic data system. The data elements may 21 include[, including] information concerning a student's: 22 23 (1) course or grade completion; 24 (2) teachers of record;

(3) assessment instrument results;
(4) receipt of special education services, including
placement in a special education program and the individualized
education program developed; and
(5) personal graduation plan as described by Section
28.0212 or 28.02121, as applicable.
