 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the composition of the board of directors of the Texas
 1-22 School Safety Center.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Sections 37.203(a) and (b), Education Code, are
 1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 (a) The center is advised by a board of directors composed
 1-27 of:

1-28 (1) the attorney general, or the attorney general's
 1-29 designee;

1-30 (2) the commissioner, or the commissioner's designee;

1-31 (3) the executive director of the Texas Juvenile
 1-32 Justice Department, or the executive director's designee;

1-33 (4) the commissioner of the Department of State Health
 1-34 Services, or the commissioner's designee;

1-35 (5) the commissioner of higher education, or the
 1-36 commissioner's designee; and

1-37 (6) the following members appointed by the governor
 1-38 with the advice and consent of the senate:

1-39 (A) a juvenile court judge;

1-40 (B) a member of a school district's board of
 1-41 trustees;

1-42 (C) an administrator of a public primary school;

1-43 (D) an administrator of a public secondary
 1-44 school;

1-45 (E) a member of the state parent-teacher
 1-46 association;

1-47 (F) a teacher from a public primary or secondary
 1-48 school;

1-49 (G) a public school superintendent who is a
 1-50 member of the Texas Association of School Administrators;

1-51 (H) a school district police officer or a peace
 1-52 officer whose primary duty consists of working in a public school;

1-53 ~~and~~

1-54 (I) a professional architect who is registered in
 1-55 this state and a member of the Texas Society of Architects; and

1-56 (J) three ~~two~~ members of the public.

1-57 (b) Members of the board appointed under Subsection (a)(6)
 1-58 serve staggered two-year terms, with the terms of the members

1-59 described by Subsections (a)(6)(A)-(F) [~~(a)(6)(A)-(E)~~] expiring on
 1-60 February 1 of each odd-numbered year and the terms of the members

1-61 described by Subsections (a)(6)(G)-(J) [~~(a)(6)(F)-(I)~~] expiring on

2-1 February 1 of each even-numbered year. A member may serve more than
2-2 one term.

2-3 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than February 1, 2020, the
2-4 governor shall appoint new members to the board of directors of the
2-5 Texas School Safety Center as required by Section 37.203(a)(6)(I),
2-6 Education Code, as amended by this Act, and Section
2-7 37.203(a)(6)(J), Education Code, as added by this Act.

2-8 (b) Section 37.203, Education Code, as amended by this Act,
2-9 does not affect the term of the member appointed under Section
2-10 37.203(a)(6)(F), Education Code, as amended by this Act, and
2-11 serving on the board immediately before the effective date of this
2-12 Act. After the term of that member expires on February 1, 2020, the
2-13 governor shall appoint a member who meets the requirements under
2-14 Section 37.203(a)(6)(F), Education Code, as amended by this Act, to
2-15 a term expiring February 1, 2021.

2-16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
