- 7 county, or emergency services district in this state that provides
- 8 or has authority to provide fire-fighting, law enforcement,
- 9 ambulance, medical, or other emergency services.
- SECTION 2. Section 772.112(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (b) A public safety answering point may transmit emergency
- 13 response requests to private safety entities, with the approval of
- 14 the board and the consent of each participating jurisdiction
- 15 serving the relevant area. A participating jurisdiction's consent
- 16 may be withdrawn at any time.
- SECTION 3. Section 772.212(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 (b) A public safety answering point may transmit emergency
- 20 response requests to private safety entities, with the approval of
- 21 the board and the consent of each [the] participating jurisdiction

- 14 SECTION 6. Section 772.614(b), Health and Safety Code, is

- 17 response requests to private safety entities, with the [board's]
- 18 approval of the board and the consent of each participating
- 19 jurisdiction serving the relevant area. A participating
- 20 jurisdiction's consent may be withdrawn at any time.
- 21 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
