## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the review of permit applications for municipal solid

- 3 waste facilities and the issuance of a notice of deficiency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 361, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 361.0661 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 361.0661. REVIEW OF PERMIT APPLICATION FOR MUNICIPAL
- 8 SOLID WASTE FACILITY; NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY. (a) The commission
- 9 shall review each application for a permit for a municipal solid
- 10 waste facility promptly.
- 11 (b) If after review of an application described by
- 12 <u>Subsection (a), the commission finds that necessary information is</u>
- 13 omitted from the application, that the application contains
- 14 incorrect information that is material to the application, or that
- 15 more information is necessary to complete the processing of the
- 16 application, the commission shall issue a notice of deficiency and
- 17 order the information to be provided to the commission not later
- 18 than the 60th day after the date the notice is issued. If the
- 19 information is not provided to the commission on or before that
- 20 date, the commission shall dismiss the application.
- 21 (c) The commission may issue a notice of deficiency for an
- 22 application described by Subsection (a) only for the reasons
- 23 specified by Subsection (b). For purposes of determining whether
- 24 an application contains incorrect information that is material to

- 1 the application, the commission may not consider administrative or
- 2 clerical errors, including typographical errors.
- 3 (d) To the extent of a conflict between this section and
- 4 Section 361.066 or a rule adopted under that section, this section
- 5 <u>controls.</u>
- 6 (e) The commission may adopt rules as necessary to implement
- 7 this section.
- 8 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 9 to an application for a permit that is submitted to the Texas
- 10 Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the effective date
- 11 of this Act. An application for a permit that was submitted to the
- 12 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality before the effective date
- 13 of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the
- 14 application was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 15 that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
