- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 153, Natural Resources
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 153.083 to read as follows:
- 7 <u>Sec. 153.083. LIMITATION</u> OF PRESCRIBED BURN DIRECTOR
- 8 LIABILITY. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), an individual
- 9 directing a prescribed burn is not liable for property damage,
- 10 personal injury, or death caused by or resulting from the burn in
- 11 excess of the insurance requirements established by the board under
- 12 <u>Section 153.046</u> if the individual has:
- (1) completed an accredited prescribed burning
- 14 training course approved by the board; and
- 15 (2) satisfied the experience requirements prescribed
- 16 by the board.
- 17 (b) This section does not apply to an individual who commits
- 18 gross negligence or intentionally causes property damage, personal
- 19 injury, or death.
- 20 SECTION 2. Section 153.083, Natural Resources Code, as
- 21 added by this Act, applies only to a cause of action that accrues on
- 22 or after the effective date of this Act.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
