1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the application for and expiration of a license to carry
 1-20 a handgun.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Sections 411.1741(a) and (b), Government Code,
 1-23 are amended to read as follows:

1-24 (a) When a person applies for an original or renewal license
 1-25 to carry a ~~concealed~~ handgun under this subchapter, the person
 1-26 may make a voluntary contribution in any amount to the fund for
 1-27 veterans' assistance established by Section 434.017.

1-28 (b) The department shall:

1-29 (1) include space on the first page of each
 1-30 application for an original or renewal license to carry a
 1-31 ~~concealed~~ handgun that allows a person applying for an original
 1-32 or renewal license to carry a ~~concealed~~ handgun to indicate the
 1-33 amount that the person is voluntarily contributing to the fund; and

1-34 (2) provide an opportunity for the person to
 1-35 contribute to the fund during the application process for an
 1-36 original or renewal license to carry a ~~concealed~~ handgun on the
 1-37 department's Internet website.

1-38 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 411.181, Government Code,
 1-39 is amended to read as follows:

1-40 Sec. 411.181. NOTICE OF CHANGE OF INFORMATION; DUPLICATE
 1-41 LICENSE [ADDRESS OR NAME].

1-42 SECTION 3. Section 411.181, Government Code, is amended by
 1-43 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

1-44 (a-1) If a license holder whose license will expire under
 1-45 Section 411.183(a)(1)(B) or (b)(1)(B) is granted an extension for
 1-46 the license holder's lawful presence in the United States as
 1-47 determined by the United States agency responsible for citizenship
 1-48 and immigration in compliance with federal law, the license holder
 1-49 may apply to the department for a duplicate license with an updated
 1-50 expiration date by providing to the department the person's license
 1-51 number and evidence of the extension. The duplicate license must
 1-52 provide for an expiration date, calculated in accordance with
 1-53 Section 411.183(a) or (b), as applicable, that takes into account
 1-54 the extension of the period for which the license holder may be
 1-55 lawfully present in the United States.

1-56 SECTION 4. Sections 411.183(a), (b), and (c), Government
 1-57 Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-58 (a) A license issued under this subchapter expires on:

1-59 (1) the earlier of:

1-60 (A) the first birthday of the license holder
 1-61 occurring after the fourth anniversary of the date of issuance; or

2-1 (B) the expiration of the license holder's lawful
2-2 presence in the United States as determined by the United States
2-3 agency responsible for citizenship and immigration in compliance
2-4 with federal law; or

2-5 (2) the first anniversary of the date of issuance, if
2-6 there is no definite expiration date for the applicant's lawful
2-7 presence in the United States.

2-8 (b) A renewed license expires on:

2-9 (1) the earlier of:

2-10 (A) the license holder's birthdate, five years
2-11 after the date of the expiration of the previous license; or

2-12 (B) the expiration of the license holder's lawful
2-13 presence in the United States as determined by the United States
2-14 agency responsible for citizenship and immigration in compliance
2-15 with federal law; or

2-16 (2) the first anniversary of the date of renewal, if
2-17 there is no definite expiration date for the applicant's lawful
2-18 presence in the United States.

2-19 (c) Except as otherwise provided by Section 411.181(a-1), a
2-20 [A] duplicate license expires on the date the license that was
2-21 duplicated would have expired.

2-22 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
2-23 an application for an original, renewal, or duplicate license to
2-24 carry a handgun submitted on or after the effective date of this
2-25 Act. An application submitted before the effective date of this Act
2-26 is governed by the law in effect on the date the application was
2-27 submitted, and the former law is continued in effect for that
2-28 purpose.

2-29 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
