15	recognized by this state as a Native American Indian Tribe
16	exercising substantial governmental powers and duties. The tribe
17	is recognized as eligible for all programs, services, and other
18	benefits provided to state-recognized Native American Indian
19	Tribes by the United States, this state, or any other state because
20	of the tribe members' status as Native American Indians.
21	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
